

**Kingsburg Public Safety Committee
Regular Meeting Minutes
October 23, 2019**

Call to order by Chair: Council Member Vince Palomar called the meeting to order at 4pm.

Approve minutes: Member Scheline made a motion to approve minutes from the July 2, 2019 Public Safety Committee meeting as prepared by City Clerk Abigail Palsgaard. The motion was seconded by Member Pursell and passed by unanimous voice vote of those members present.

Accept David Lay's resignation from the Committee and open for a 30 day recruitment.

A motion was made by Member Marshall, seconded by Member McGuire, to accept the resignation of David Lay. The motion passed by unanimous voice vote of those members present.

Crosswalk Visibility Discussion

Chairman Palomar discussed the crosswalks around schools. The Committee discussed faded crosswalk stripes around schools and at 6th & Kern and 14th & Stroud. They spoke about lighted cross walks.

Member Pursell made a motion to make a recommendation to Council to request the crosswalks around the schools and at 6th/Kern and 14th/Stroud be repainted to improve the visibility for pedestrian safety. The motion was seconded by Member McGuire and passed by unanimous voice vote of those members present.

Member Pursell made a motion to recommend Staff research the current cost of a lighted crosswalk and the potential of 50/50 cost sharing with the school district for the crosswalk at Roosevelt School and the crosswalk on 18th from Memorial Park and for staff to research standalone lighted crosswalk signs as an alternate. The motion was seconded by Member Ray and passed by unanimous voice vote of those members present.
