

**RESOLUTION NO. 2012-15****A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF KINGSBURG  
AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY REDUCTION OF THE AMOUNT OF CITY OF  
KINGSBURG CAPITAL FACILITIES FEES**

At a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Kingsburg duly called and held on February 15, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. on said day, it was moved by Councilmember Karstetter, seconded by Councilmember Roman and duly carried that the following Resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, subject to applicable provisions of California law, development impact fees may be established and charged to pay for the cost of development and construction of public facilities and capital improvements and the purchase of equipment needed as a result of new development; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 15.48 of Title 15 of the City of Kingsburg Municipal Code requires the payment of Capital Facilities Fees as a condition of approval of development projects for the purpose of defraying the costs of facilities and equipment (collectively, "Facilities and Equipment") needed as a result of new development projects as identified in that certain Comprehensive Impact Fee Study dated March 1, 2004 ("Fee Study") prepared by Muni Financial for the City of Kingsburg; and

WHEREAS, the national, state and local economies are slowly recovering from a major economic recession; and

WHEREAS, economic development for retail, commercial and industrial properties in the City of Kingsburg has seen very limited activity over the past three to four years; and

WHEREAS, the current amount of Capital Facilities Fees that must be paid as a condition to the development of property in the City of Kingsburg creates a deterrent for such development in the City of Kingsburg; and

1 WHEREAS, the Kingsburg Economic Development Committee has  
 2 proposed to the Kingsburg City Council an incentive program ("**Incentive**  
 3 **Program**") to encourage new retail, commercial and industrial projects to locate  
 4 within the city limits of the City of Kingsburg; and

5 WHEREAS, one aspect of the Incentive Program is a proposal to reduce all  
 6 Capital Facilities Fees by twenty-five percent (25%) for a period of three (3) years  
 7 to encourage all types of development within the city limits of the City of  
 8 Kingsburg; and

9 WHEREAS, the City Council finds that a twenty-five percent (25%)  
 10 reduction in the City's Capital Facilities Fees for a period of three (3) years will not  
 11 prohibit or delay the construction, installation or purchase of Facilities or  
 12 Equipment; and

13 NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 15.48 of  
 14 Title 15 of the City of Kingsburg Municipal Code and in order to stimulate income  
 15 generating and job producing development in the City of Kingsburg. BE IT  
 16 RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kingsburg as follows:

17 1. All provisions set forth above are true and correct and are hereby  
 18 incorporated herein by reference as findings.

19 2. All of the City's Capital Facilities Fees are reduced by twenty-five  
 20 percent (25%) for the period commencing March 1, 2012 and end February 28, 2015  
 21 and for that time period the City's Capital Facilities Fees shall be as follows:

3. In order for the twenty-five percent (25%) reduction to apply the following criteria must be satisfied:

(a) Final land use entitlement approval must be obtained during the period commencing March 1, 1012 and ending February 28, 2015.

(b) Construction/building permits must be issued within one (1) year after the date of final land use entitlement approval.

4. Effective March 1, 2015, all Capital Facilities Fees shall revert back to the amounts existing on the date of this Resolution, subject to adjustment in accordance with the provisions of Section 15.48.140 of Chapter 15.48 of Title 15 of the Kingsburg Municipal Code.


