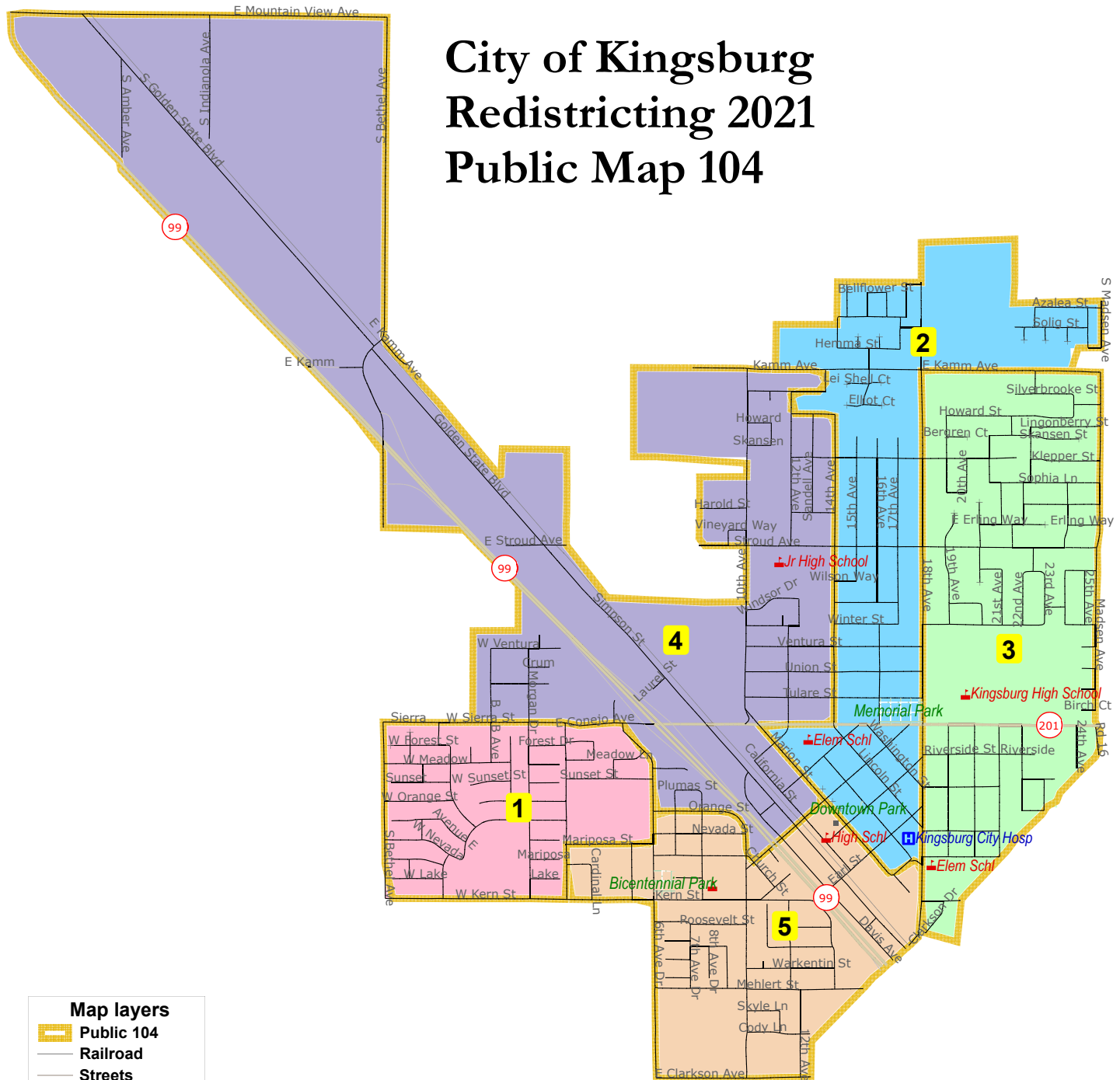







# City of Kingsburg Redistricting 2021 Public Map 104
