Dear Resident,

The State Water Resources Control Board requires the City of Kingsburg to collect water samples from single family structures that may contain lead or copper pipes, or pipes coupled with lead solder installed after 1982 and /or served by lead main service lines. These samples are collected every three years with the help of Kingsburg residents since they must be collected from an inside faucet.

A sample is to be collected after water has been sitting in the pipes for six hours (i.e., no water uses during this period.) Due to this requirement, either early mornings or evenings upon returning home from work are the best times for collecting samples. Please take a few minutes to look at the enclosed instructions and call the Kingsburg Public Works

Department if you have any questions. We will assume that you are willing to participate unless we hear otherwise from you.

On **Monday July 18, 2022**, Water Dept. staff will deliver a one-liter container along with sampling instructions to your door. If there is nobody at home when the delivery is made, the container and instructions will be left at your front door. Please read the directions for sample collection and provide the requested information. The filled container with the requested information can then be left outside the front door for pickup by Water Dept. Staff on **Tuesday, July 19, 2022**.

The City appreciates your cooperation in this sampling program. If it is not possible for you to collect the sample, please notify the Kingsburg Public Works Department immediately at 559-725-5512. Thank you for your help with this important tap sampling program.
