






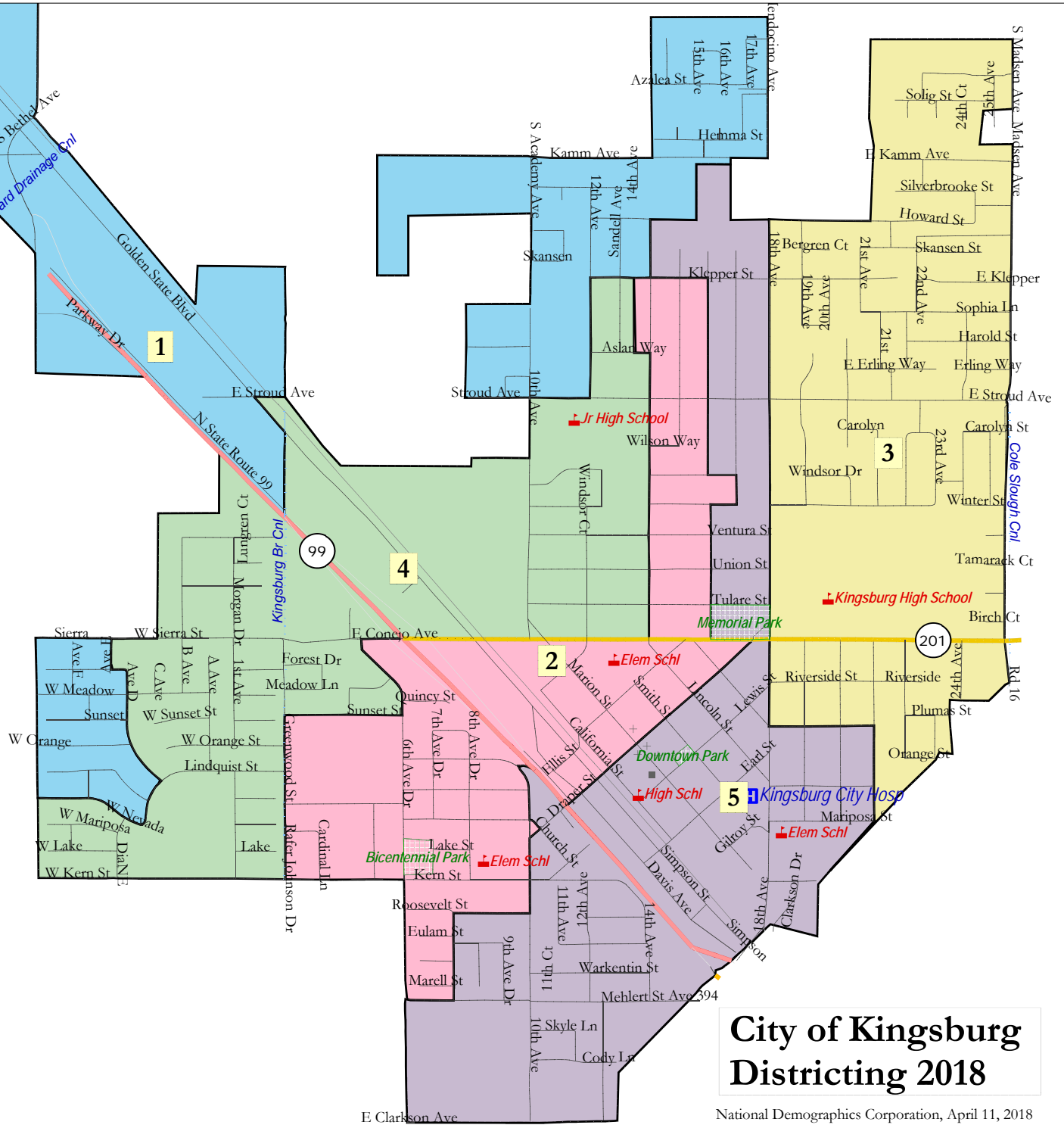


Public Map 109
